SELECTMEN COMMITTEE REPORTS

Jon stated that Joe Young is in Mount Vernon for the Broadband Committee. There will be a 6:00 Zoom meeting for Broadband in 2 weeks.

TOWN MANAGER REPORT

Mark Robinson updated the Board of Selectmen on the net position of the Town. Mark stated that tax collection rates need to be monitored in the upcoming months. Mark stated the Public Works have been busy with road work. Mark updated the Board of Selectmen regarding an incident on Friday, where the State Police were called for an individual acting oddly at the Town Office and the Public Works Office.

OLD BUSINESS

20-28 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING/LOCAL AND STATE ELECTION STATUS

Mark and the Board of Selectmen discussed the prepared Referendum and Election Warrant for School Committee and Board of Selectmen for the July 14th Election. Mark and the Board of Selectmen discussed the Local Referendum questions regarding the Richmond Mills Culvert and a school bus for the Fayette Central School. 20-39 TAX FORECLOSURE SALE

20-40 COLD MIX PAVEMENT BID RESULTS
